ALSPACH BROTHERS BOTH TOP 10 TUESDAY IN SUMMER SHOOTOUT

CONCORD, N.C. – Both Zack and Trevor Alspach finished in the top 10 in Tuesday night's semi-pro legends car 20-lap feature in the Quaker Steak & Lube Summer Shootout at Lowe's Motor Speedway. Trevor, 15, started eighth and finished ninth while Zack, 17, started in a deep 22nd position and made his way up to finish 10th in the 28-car field.

"It was another wild race," Zack said Wednesday morning. "We started back a ways and dodged a few wrecks and then passed some cars to get up to the top 10. I could see my brother there at the end and I was catching him but ran out of time. We just keep doing the best we can and the car is getting better each week. I'm glad to see Trevor pick up a good run, too."

Lately, Zack has been having solid runs at another North Carolina oval, Caraway Speedway in Asheboro, N.C. Friday night, the elder Alspach brother finished second in the semi-pro feature while Trevor finished fourth.

"Caraway has been pretty good to us this summer," Zack commented. "We won there a couple weeks ago and ended up second last Friday. We're going to Bowman Gray Stadium this Friday for a big race up there. It'll be my first time running there so we'll see how it goes. We're looking forward to the challenge."

Both Zack and Trevor will race at Bowman Gray Stadium Friday and are tentatively planning to take Saturday night off.

Zack Alspach and his brother, Trevor, are legends car racers from Willingboro, N.J. Former micro-sprint racers, the Alspach brothers have a number of feature victories in legends cars since beginning their tenure in the INEX-sanctioned class in 2007.

The Alspach brothers are members of the Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development Program and are represented by Driver Development Services, Inc., Charlotte, N.C.
