TREVOR ALSPACH NINTH TO THIRD AT SHENANDOAH, ZACK ALSPACH SIXTH

SHENANDOAH, Va. – Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development racing brothers Trevor and Zack Alspach finished third and sixth Saturday in the Legends car race at Virginia's Shenandoah Speedway. Trevor, 15, started ninth in the 15-car field and methodically moved to the front of the field before finishing third, less than one second behind the winner of the 25-lap affair.

"We can't complain," Trevor said. "We passed a bunch of cars and our car was running really well. Toward the end of the race we started to lose the brakes. I think there's a problem with one of the brake lines. We'll get it fixed and hopefully get a win next time."

"Next time" for the Alspach brothers is a special \$500-to-win Memorial Day race at Shenandoah on Monday, May 26. The Alspach Racing team plans to make the four-hour trip south to Shenandoah from their Willingboro, N.J., home on Memorial Day while continuing to anticipate the 15th annual Summer Shootout at Lowe's Motor Speedway in North Carolina beginning June 10.
