

ZACK ALSPACH HAS LEGENDS, LATE MODELS PLANNED FOR 2008

WILLINGBORO, N.J. ó Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development racer Zack Alspach recently tested a late-model at Hickory Motor Speedway (N.C.) and plans on it not being the last time he'll strap into a full-size stock car in 2008. Alspach's test was part of the Team Full Throttle's Late Model Shakedown Day on Feb. 2.

õWe got about 40 laps in Ed Cox's Tri-Star Motorsports car and it went really well,ö the 16-year-old Alspach began. õI feel like I got a good feel for the car and the extra horsepower it has. The test was the best thing for me in preparing to race a late-model later in 2008. I want to thank TFT for putting the day together for us.ö

In 2007, Alspach competed in legends cars and won three races at Wall Township Speedway in New Jersey. He plans to continue his legends effort in 2008 while also focusing on a tentative mid-summer relocation to North Carolina. Upon arrival to the Tar Heel State, Alspach plans to gain more experience in a late-model.

õWe're going to focus on the legends car to start the season, but we definitely want to get some rides in a late-model later in the summer. We've done well in the legends and I think we can do well in the late-model too. I'm looking forward to getting to North Carolina and running on some of the tracks down there. It should be a fun season.ö

Zack's younger brother Trevor will also continue his legends effort for the 2008 racing season, while also testing a late model for a possible step up in 2009.
